



In Uganda, 94% of households are currently depending on wood fuels (charcoal and firewood); this endangers severely the ecosystem, with local highly expressed consequences on livelihoods of communities.

Good Life Foundation is fighting that deforestation, The ground field sees flawless performance through unrelinquished efforts in supporting disabled and poorest of poor community members to adopt Liquefied Petroleum Gas Clean Cooking Solution.

Good Life Foundation, after having conducted series of researches and assessments, referring to its Environmental Protection Monitoring Data, is exceptionally impacting lives of vulnerability and poverty-stricken households. They are benefiting from a series of activities including;

- Identification,
- Trainings: Clean Cooking solution awareness, finance literacy, environment protection basic skills, LP Gas safety, business startup skills,
- Clean Cooking LP Gas starter equipment (cylinders etc.),



- Initial finance resources targeting strategic project sustainability by socio-economic empowerment.
- Monitoring
- More mentorship.

Besides the above highlights, this foundation steps further into broadening its philanthropy to a larger number of 1,724 beneficiaries, empowered to adopt clean cooking solution. This strategy is set to emerge as the bastion model aimed at transformation of vulnerability into Environment Protection Watchdog through social economic empowerment. To materialize such ideation, this foundation designed the LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS CLEAN COOKING IMPACT TO THWART DEFORESTATION IN UGANDA, the project is in the acronym of LP Gas CCIT-D Uganda -#1. A dual impact project tailed to combat deforestation by social economic empowerment rendering beneficiaries an environment protective panel regionally.
